OPERATION


Place the grinder at the left end of the bedknife with the Angle Guide Bracket flat against the bottom of the bedknife. **NOTE:** With the Angle Guide Bracket flat against the bottom of the bedknife you will get a 5 of front face angle. (See Fig. 2)

The Reel Guide Bracket will push on the back side of the reel blade to move it out of the way.

With a smooth consistent stroke grind the bedknife from left to right. **NOTE:** You will grind from left to right on most reels which have normal helix reel blades. If you are grinding a reverse helix reel you will be grinding from right to left.

If you tilt the grinder into the reel you will reduce the front face angle. Figure 3 illustrates a 0° front face angle by tilting the grinder into the reel 5°.

If you tilt the grinder away from the reel you will increase the front face angle. Figure 4 illustrates a 10° front face angle by tilting the grinder away from the reel 5°.

ASSEMBLY

Remove the grinding wheel from your 4 1/2" angle grinder. (Black & Decker Model 2750 & 2750 G or Sears Craftsman Model 900.277230)


Remove grinding wheel guard from grinder.

Assemble the 620050-Facing Tool Base to your grinder. (See Fig. 1) **NOTE:** Make sure the counter bore in the base is seated against the face of the grinder head.

Position the Base at the proper angle you prefer to grind and clamp into place with the (2) #8-32 X 5/8" Socket Head Cap Screws.

Replace the grinding wheel flange, grinding wheel and grinding wheel nut. NOTE: Check clearances between grinding wheel and base. If wheel is rubbing against base, recheck that base is properly seated.

Assemble the Angle Guide Bracket and Reel Guide Bracket with hardware as shown. (See Fig. 1) The Angle Bracket is mounted with the bottom set of holes for most bedknives, but if the front face grinding surface is more that approximately 5/16" above the bottom of the bedknife you will need to mount the bracket in the top set of holes.
